Our back-to-school night will be run a little differently this fall. Since we can't all gather face-to-face, Msgr. Shecterle, Fr. Linn and I will be prerecording our messages and classroom teachers will be inviting parents to join them via Zoom for a brief overview and to answer any questions you might have.

Our current plan still includes reopening for in-person instruction with all students attending five days a week. At-home learning options are available for those who are unable to attend due to special circumstances.
