Director of Teaching: From the Desk of Mrs. Mogilevsky: "When helping your child with math at home, asking thoughtful questions can encourage deeper understanding and build their confidence. Start by asking open-ended questions like, "How did you

figure that out?" or "What do you notice?" This helps you gain insight into their thinking and guides them in explaining their reasoning. You don't need to have all the answers—modeling curiosity and learning alongside your child teaches them valuable problem-solving skills."
