

Dear Families,

If your child came home with a seemingly wild story about the school roof this week, there is probably some truth to it. However, please know the roof was never in danger of falling in. Maintenance work on replacing the roof has been taking place over the last few weeks. This work was slated to be done in a short window but was delayed due to rain. As they are trying to finish up this week, there has been quite a bit of noise off and on throughout the day, so our first through fourth graders have had quite an adventure. Fortunately, there is no school for the remainder of the week and no rain in the foreseeable future so everything should be wrapped up when the kids return on Monday.

What's going around? We have had several reported cases of strep and COVID over the past couple of weeks. To help minimize the spread of disease, students should stay home from school when they are ill. If your child tests positive for COVID it is recommended that you follow the current CDC guidelines. Masking is not required, but will be supported. Please note that students who have been exposed to COVID and are asymptomatic do NOT need to quarantine, as long as they remain asymptomatic. Free COVID test kits are available in the school office.

If your child has been ill, he/she should not return to school until free of symptoms and fever for 24 hours (without fever reducing medication) and is ready to participate fully in all school activities, recess included. Generally, if children are well enough to be in school for classes, they are well enough to go outside and get some fresh air during the recess and noon hour breaks. If an exception is needed, the principal should be consulted.
