PLAYGROUND UPDATE: Another big announcement that was made at the gala was regarding the school playground project. Thanks to the parish and Love One Another funds contributing 75% of the project, an additional LOA grant from the Archdiocese of Milwaukee, and reduced costs due to volunteers helping to do the installation, we only need to raise \$10,000 for the school playground project! The contracts will be signed in the next week or so.

ALMSGIVING PROJECT: Our buy-out day netted \$317.76 that will go towards shipping our shoe donations to Africa. Thanks for supporting our Almsgiving outreach project! We will be accepting shoe donations through Monday, March 25th. Mrs. Mogilevski and I, along with sixteen middle school volunteers, will be delivering our donation to the SFJ site on Wednesday, March 27. While there we will help out by cleaning, sorting, and preparing the shoes for shipping to Africa.


