The Devotion of the Brown Scapular

Those enrolled in the brown scapular promise to wear the scapular, to observe chastity according to their state in life, and to pray the Little Office of the Blessed Virgin Mary daily or abstain from meat on Wednesdays and Saturdays or pray three Hail Mary's daily. It is also piously believed that Mary revealed to Pope John XXII that she would free those devoted to the wearing of the brown scapular on the Saturday after their death, a grace known as the Sabbatine privilege: "As a tender Mother, I will descend into purgatory on the Saturday after

their death, and will deliver them into the heavenly mansions of life everlasting."

On the day of enrollment, one can also obtain a plenary indulgence, normal conditions being

Those who would like to practice this devotion are invited to be enrolled in the brown scapular after all May 12 and 13 Masses, at both parishes. Please bring your brown scapular with you (or obtain one prior to Mass. 
