Summer Pilgrimage and Retreat Opportunities for Youth

As we enter the home stretch of the academic calendar, I want to remind you about—and invite you to register your children for—two rich **summer opportunities** our parishes are facilitating for current and rising middle- and high-school students:

- June 24-26:** Joined by Fr. Michael Malucha, Vocations Director for the Archdiocese of Milwaukee, we will make a **pilgrimage to the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in La Crosse, WI**. We will camp at Goose Island (5 miles from the Shrine) for two nights and visit the Shrine for the day on Wednesday, June 25. Cost is \$50 per person and \$25 for each additional child from the same family. **Open to all current and rising 6th-8th graders.** Deadline to [register](#) is May 16.
- June 23-27 and July 7-11:** **ND Summer Vision for High School Students**. This five-day conference-camp-retreat is run by the McGrath Institute for Church Life at the University of Notre Dame. **Thanks to a scholarship provision, the cost to parishioners is only \$300.** This includes all food, lodging, instruction, and materials for the week on Notre Dame's beautiful campus. **Open to all current and rising 9th-12th graders.** Deadline to [indicate interest](#) is May 16.

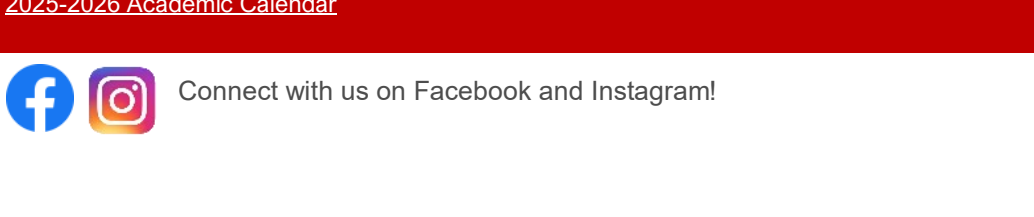

Congrats to several members of our St. Mary's Track Team!

St. Mary's Track Team had FOUR school records broken in our meet last Saturday. Lexi Rocolo broke the 5th grade 400m dash record with the time of 1:11.83. Kellan Latham broke 2 records!
