Dear Families,

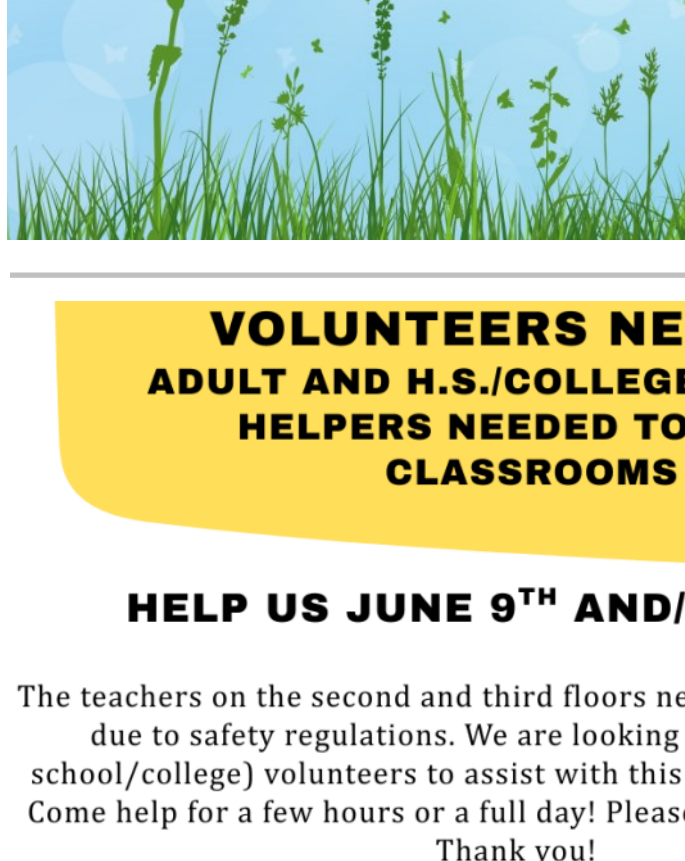

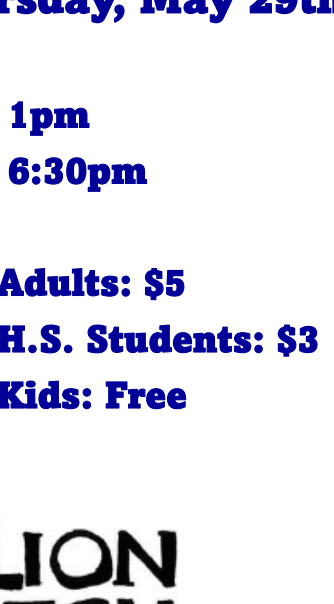
HELP US JUNE 9TH AND/OR 10TH!

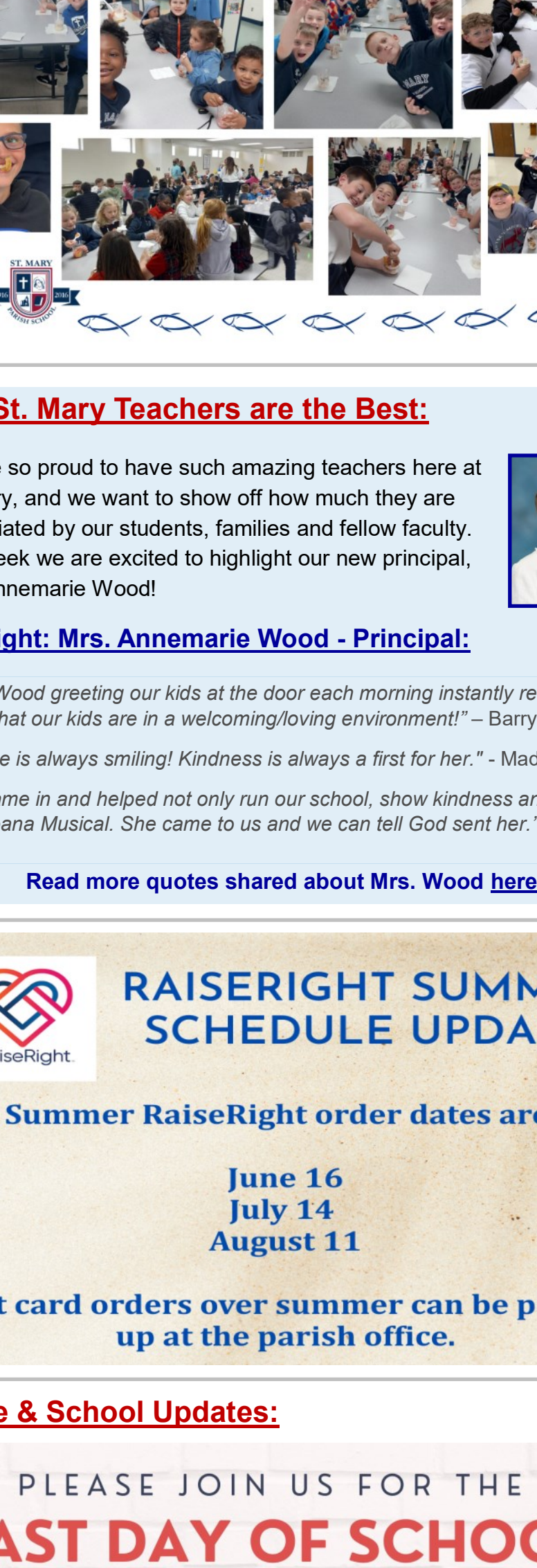

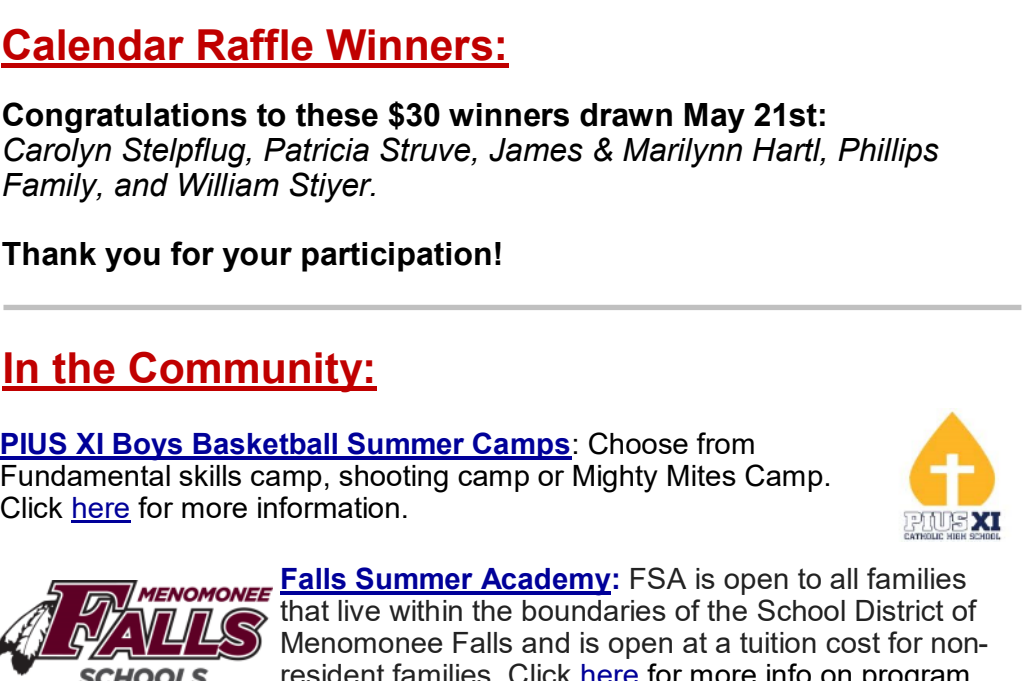
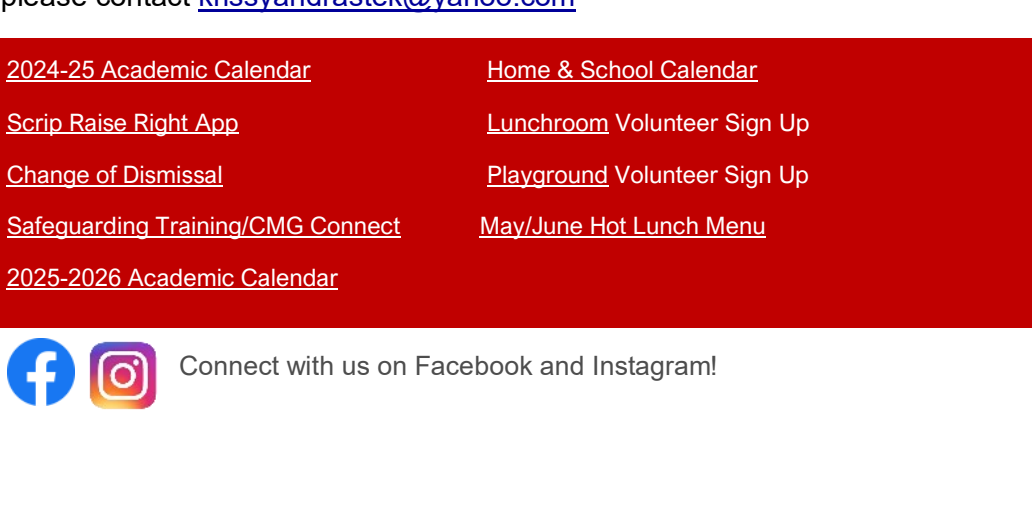
Spotlight: Mrs. Annemarie Wood - Principal:

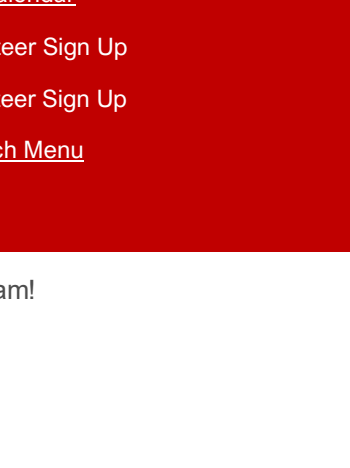
