In the coming months, St. Mary and Meitler will work collaboratively to analyze all aspects of school life. Our goal is to strengthen areas of school life that are most effective while we look for opportunities to grow. The overall objective of this process is to develop a comprehensive strategic plan for St. Mary Parish School that will be mission-driven,

visionary, long-range, comprehensive, achievable, and integrated. (Think of it as a

roadmap we will use to guide planning and decision-making)

focusing on the four primary "domains" of school life, as outlined by The National Standards and Benchmarks for Effective Catholic Elementary and Secondary Schools (NSBECES). These are Catholic mission and identity, academic excellence, strong governance and leadership, and operational vitality. Meitler has already begun meeting with school staff and parish leadership. Parents, teachers, parishioners, and community members will be invited to participate in the planning process throughout the next few months, in a variety of ways, from serving on


