I want our school to stay welcoming and open for those who are part of our community. I also want to keep out those who could harm my students and staff. Your support in following the procedures is greatly appreciated!

Safety & Security Plan 2024-2025 – Key Points:

Purpose: Enhance the safety and well-being of students, staff, and visitors.

Building Entry Procedures:

- **New Requirement:** All parents, guardians, visitors, and volunteers must enter through the front school office door and sign in every time.
- Back Activity Center Doors: These doors will no longer be accessible for entry during school hours to enhance security.

General Safety Guidelines:

- **Visitor Protocol:** Sign in at the front office and wear a visitor badge at all times.
- Emergency Contact Updates: Ensure that emergency contact information is always up to date.

"Lock In" Procedure:

- Initiation: When there is a potential threat nearby but no immediate danger on campus.
- Actions: Normal activities continue within secured classrooms; no entry or exit from the building.

"Lock Down" Procedure:

- Initiation: When there is an immediate or credible threat inside or near the building.
- Actions: Doors locked, lights off, students remain silent and hidden until it is safe.

Closing: Your cooperation is crucial to maintaining a secure learning environment. Please review and discuss these procedures with your children.


2025 Calendar Raffle

Next week, students will take the i-Ready Diagnostic, an adaptive test that adjusts to their responses, giving us valuable insights to support their learning. i-Ready is our new online assessment program replacing NWEA MAP. It identifies your child's strengths and areas for growth, personalizes their learning, and monitors progress throughout the year.

How can you help?

Ensure your child gets a good night's sleep, encourage them to do their best without rushing, and reassure them that it's okay not to know every answer.

What happens next?
