

TUITION TAX CREDIT

CLARIFICATIONS

Here are some tips to assist you when calculating your tuition credit for your State Tax return: You must log into Smart Tuition at https://parent.smarttuition.com to obtain

The 'Total Paid in 2021' on the statement from Smart Tuition is a total of EVERYTHING (field trips, lunches, t-shirts, etc.) you purchased in 2021. The deduction can $\underline{\mathit{only}}$ be used for the $\underline{\mathit{tuition amount paid}}$ out by the parent or guardian. This amount is listed out separately on the summary from Smart Tuition. Please make sure you are using the correct amount. New This Year: <u>Before/After Care Program billing</u>. The amount is also listed out on the statement and is the necessary documentation needed for

the amount you paid in tuition in 2021. Upon logging in, click on 'Family Year End Statement' found on the upper right hand side of the screen. A PDF copy will download and you can print and save a copy to your PC.
