#### Dear Families,

We continue to have quite a few students ill this week. To help minimize the spread of germs, please make sure to keep your child home until they have been symptom free (fever, vomiting, etc.) for at least 24 hours before they return to school. Students with confirmed cases of influenza should follow their doctors' recommendations for when they return. We are reminding students about proper handwashing, coughing/sneezing into elbow or tissue, sanitizing surfaces and bathrooms daily, making hand sanitizer available and have posted hand washing reminder signs. We have also asked students not to share food with one another. It would be great if you could also echo these reminders to your children. <u>Click here for the Health policy</u>.
