FOOD DRIVE: As part of our Catholic Schools Week celebration, we engage in some type of service project to give

back to our community. This year, we collected food for the Menomonee Falls Food Pantry. With a little friendly competition,

we collected 1,450 food items. The top three classrooms are: Mrs. Barenz for primary, Mrs. Kleinman for intermediate, and Mrs. Schroeder for middle school. These classrooms will receive an out-of-uniform day for their service efforts. HOT LUNCH NEWS! We have selected a hot lunch vendor and are in the process of finalizing the contract. We are hopeful that the new vendor, Fresh & Safe, will be able to start offering hot lunches the week of February 14, but we are still waiting on

confirmation of that. We are also in the process of applying to

become part of the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) so you can continue to receive the current "free lunch" benefits. This is a process that requires some time and training. We were told it takes 4-6 weeks to get approved, so in the interim you will need to pay the actual cost of the lunch. The new vendor's price per lunch (including milk) is \$4.45. This is \$.65 more than the \$3.80 price Menomonee Falls was charging us two years ago. We hope to continue with Domino's pizza lunches on Wednesday's, however NSLP requirements will not allow us to use the profits from those lunches for tuition scholarships. We may also have to tweak the Wednesday menu slightly, so we are meeting the NSLP nutritional requirements.






