Do you have a New Year's resolution to save money this year? Since June 1, St Mary's families have earned over \$19,000 in rebates using Scrip. If you haven't used Scrip yet, give it a try—it's easy! If you already use Scrip, make sure you are maximizing your earnings. Here are a few simple steps to earn more rebates with Scrip. Remember, you have until May 31 to reach your \$250 fundraising requirement, and anything beyond that is a credit towards next year's tuition.

- 1-You can't save if you don't have an account.** Register at www.shopwithscrip.com. The enrollment code is: DDEC-C7621L46
- 2-Link your bank account.** This way you can purchase Scrip electronically, when you need it. E-giftcards account for over 60% of purchases at St Mary School.
- 3-Use the RaiseRight app.** Scrip's mobile app lets you easily organize your e-giftcards, and use your phone to redeem your Scrip at retailers or online.
- 4-Use reloads.** You can use the [RaiseRight app](#) to reload funds onto many of the gift cards you have purchased. Get a gas or grocery card and then use it over and over. St Mary families have already reloaded over \$130,000 so far this year.
- 5-Watch for the special deals.** Scrip often offers bonus rebates; stock up for extra savings. Check your account settings, and make sure you are signed up to receive notices about special offers.

TUITION TAX CREDIT CLARIFICATIONS



Here are some tips to assist you when calculating your tuition credit for your State Tax return:

- ✓ You must log into Smart Tuition at <https://parent.smarttuition.com> to obtain the amount you paid in tuition in 2020. Upon logging in, click on 'Family Year End Statement' found on the upper right hand side of the screen. A PDF copy will download and you can print and save a copy to your PC.
- ✓ The 'Total Paid in 2020' on the statement from Smart Tuition is a total of **EVERYTHING** (field trips, lunches, t-shirts, etc.) you purchased in 2020.
- ✓ The deduction can *only* be used for the **tuition amount paid** out by the parent or guardian. This amount is listed out separately on the summary from Smart Tuition. Please make sure you are using the correct amount.
- ✓ New This Year: **After Care Program billing**. The amount is also listed out on the statement and is the necessary documentation needed for tax purposes.


