#### Dear Families,

Trimester report cards were emailed home today for students in grades 1-8. Please check your junk/spam folder if you did not receive your child's. If you cannot locate the report card in your junk mail folder, please contact the school office.

Over the last year, technology has become a mainstream part of our interactions and communication within our school and at home. Technology can be a powerful tool but brings with it many new avenues for interactions, information, and behaviors that can be concerning. While we recognize that technology has played an integral part in the digital learning environment, we also recognize that it can place a child in a vulnerable position to be exploited or exposed to unsafe interactions or situations if not carefully monitored.

Our school issued Chromebooks provide a safe digital environment for our students. Content is filtered and monitored 24/7 by school staff. Students are not allowed to download or use unapproved apps or sites and all searches are recorded. Blocked search information is monitored by staff members and available to parents.

Have you noticed that your child spends more time "talking" to his/her friends through social media and texting apps than talking face-to-face? Do you know what social media apps he/she is using? The Archdiocesan Safe Environment Office recently shared some information about

the TikTok app that will provide you with some facts about the app and explain some of the dangers and #language your child could be using and/or exposed to. I hope that you will take some time to read through this important information. Please join us next Friday at 1:30 p.m. as we will be livestreaming the Stations of the

Cross. The stations will be led by our eighth-grade students. If you can't join us for the livestream the recording will be available on the parish YouTube channel later in the day.


