<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Families acknowledge and understand their role in keeping sick students home ● Families complete a daily health screening ● Staff will monitor students for potential symptoms during school day ● Students with symptoms during school day go directly to health room ● Any student presenting with COVID symptoms will be isolated and monitored until parent arrives ● Masks are strongly recommended while indoors 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Student cohorts will be used to minimize interactions and assist in contact tracing ● Excess furniture has been removed to allow for social distancing between student desks ● Teachers are encouraged to take students outdoors to learn whenever possible ● Masks are strongly recommended when physical distancing is not possible ● Limited sharing of objects or community supplies ● Portable plexiglass barrier for teacher use ● Middle school students using a block schedule 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Main office and cafeteria fitted with plexiglass barriers ● Recess - students will play with cohort ● Lockers - limited use to lessen hallway congestion ● Restroom use will be staggered ● Signs posted to remind students and staff of hygiene practices and social distancing ● PE and other classes will be held outside as weather permits 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Car Riders should not be dropped off before 7:50 AM ● Dismissal - students will be dismissed at various times (few minutes apart) to minimize congregating. ● Bus Protocols- Students must wear masks on busses.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Learning surfaces disinfected daily ● Sanitation areas will be available at entry/exits, classrooms and common areas ● Increased cleaning of high-touch surfaces, bathrooms, high traffic areas ● Unit ventilators cleaned and filters replaced ● Using EPA approved disinfectants and cleaning supplies 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Lunch times and schedules have been modified to allow for social distancing ● Students will be given time to wash hands before lunch, rather than use hand sanitizer ● No sharing of food or snacks ● Hot lunch prepared by MFSD 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● All staff will complete a daily health screening before arriving to work ● Will adhere to social distancing where feasible 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Visitors and volunteers should complete a daily health screening before arriving at school. ● Masks are strongly recommended for visitors and volunteers when in the school building ● Water fountains may be used for refill but not for drinking. Students will need a refillable water bottle each day. ● Birthday snacks should be individually wrapped.
