

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do I communicate a change of dismissal for my student?

Should your student need to be picked up before normal dismissal time, or the mode of transportation has changed for the day, parents are asked to complete the [Change of Dismissal Form found on our website.](#) This is an important communication for the school office and should be completed as early in the day as possible. By completing the on-line form, this information is immediately sent to the school office. You may also [print off a paper copy](#) and forward to the office through your students homeroom teacher.
