Dear Families,

Technology did not cooperate on Wednesday when we tried livestreaming the Rosary from the Church to the classrooms. However, students were still able to pray the rosary and reflect on the Luminous Mysteries, as a class. Even though we could not livestream the Rosary service, we were able to record it. [Please click here](#) to pray the Rosary with our eighth-grade leaders.

Students in grades K5-8 will begin MAP Growth testing on Monday, October 5. MAP Growth is a computer adaptive test. That means every student gets a unique set of test questions based on responses to previous questions. As the student answers correctly, questions get harder. If the student answers incorrectly, the questions get easier. By the end of the test, most students will have answered about half the questions correctly, as is common on adaptive tests. The purpose of MAP Growth is to determine what the student knows and is ready to learn next. As always, please make sure your child gets a good night's sleep and a good breakfast so he or she is ready to go. And please remember to send a healthy snack and a water bottle each day.

With the uptick of COVID-19 cases in Wisconsin, it is important that we stay vigilant in our efforts to mitigate the spread. To make this work, we need everyone's cooperation and assistance. We need you to continue to do a [daily health screening](#) with your child on school days. If your child is ill, please keep him or her at home until he or she is released by a doctor or are fever and symptom free, without medication, for 24 hours. We have been fortunate thus far that we have not seen any "community spread" at school. In other words, if an individual has tested positive, we have not had other individuals within that class or grade test positive. Keep your fingers crossed and say a lot of prayers that we can continue to maintain our current level of mitigation as we move into flu season.

Speaking of flu season, the CDC and public health departments are encouraging everyone to get vaccinated against influenza, this fall. Please contact your health provider for more information.
