For comparison, local data for the Menomonee Falls School District reports 133 students in guarantine and 11 active cases. Of the 11 cases, none are at the elementary schools. Hems on skirts and jumpers should fall to the knee. Socks must be solid black, white, navy or red without patterns

- or logos.
- Hair may not be dyed to an unnatural hair color or unnatural look, must not be cut in a distracting manner and must be groomed appropriately. Extreme hair styles such as mohawks,
- fohawks, shaved heads or shaved sculpted letters or designs in hairstyles are not allowed. Boys' hair must be trimmed so it is above the eyebrows and above the shirt collar. Girls' hair must be kept out of the eyes at all times. Piercings are limited to one pair of earrings and must be in the earlobe. Earrings should be smaller than a dime and not dangling.
- Hats, kerchiefs, large bows, headbands, jewelry items, and other accessories must never present a safety hazard, a distraction or draw undue attention.

Accessories should be small in size and reflect uniform colors.

Nail polish is acceptable.

Makeup is not allowed.


