See you on Wednesday, August 24th for our back-to-school parent meeting. Please note we will be doing school pictures during Open house on Friday, August 26th.

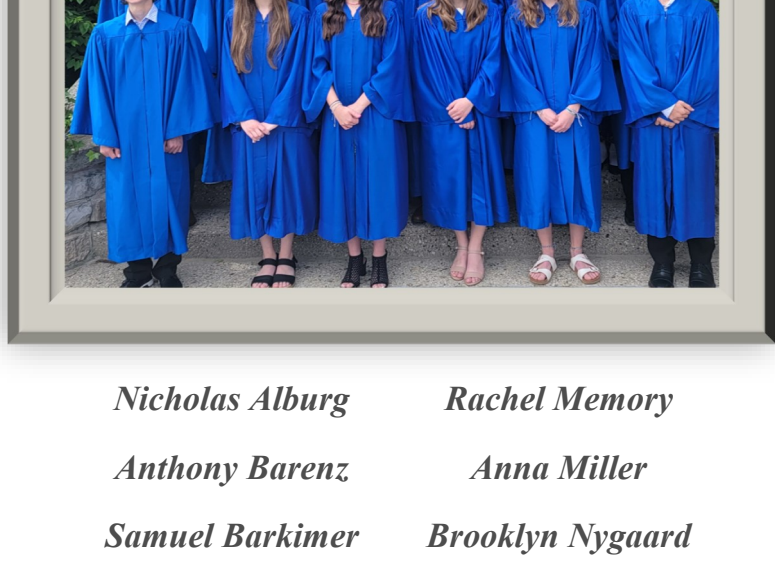

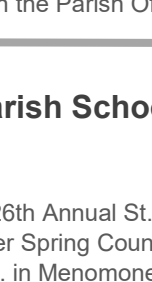
Student Medications: Student medication may be picked up from the school office through June 17 (medications not picked up by this time will be disposed of).

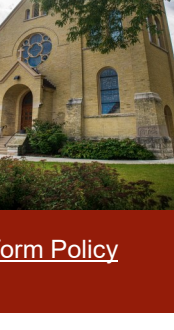
St. Mary Parish School Annual Golf Outing: Sept. 18
